



Transferability of Credit Policy

Any student transferring from another institution to Valley Grande Institute for Academic Studies is eligible for admission if the previously attended institution is an approved school or an accredited institution. Other institutions are not obligated to accept transfer course hours from Valley Grande Institute for Academic Studies.

Academic course hours and tuition credit will be given for courses completed at another accredited institution. Only those accrediting agencies recognized by the United States Department of Education or the Council for Higher Education Accreditation are considered accredited institutions. However, the request must occur at the time of application and must be reviewed and approved by the School Director.

Transferring students must produce an official transcript at the time of application. Courses completed outside the United States will be either evaluated by the school or by AACRAO (American Associates of Collegiate Registrars and Admissions Officers)

Valley Grande Institute for Academic Studies students repeating a program will receive academic and tuition credit for courses completed if such courses meet program requirements. Students may be required to audit courses previously completed.

Vocational Nursing Students may re-enroll only once after their original enrollment to complete courses failed and to continue in the program. Vocational Nursing courses completed twelve months or more prior to re-enrollment will be repeated.

Valley Grande Institute for Academic Studies currently does not have any Articulation Agreements in place with any other institutions.
